

STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

I JEFFREY NORMAN MILES of Trewollack Farm, St Mawes, Truro, Cornwall DO
SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY declare as follows :-

1. I am and have been since 29th April 1969 the owner of the land known as Trewollack, St Mawes, Truro, Cornwall. The present constitution of the farm is shown edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration and includes two areas of land acquired since the 29th April 1969.

- 1997* 2. On the *5th* day of *August* 1997 I deposited with Cornwall County Council being the appropriate Council a Statement accompanied by a map delineating my property by red edging which stated that no ways over the land have been dedicated as highways.

- 1997* 3. No ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the map accompanying this Application since this statement dated the *5th* day of *August* 1997 referred to in paragraph 2 above and at the present time I have no intention of dedicating any public rights of way over my property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the *4th* day of *September* One thousand nine hundred and ninety seven conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
