**CAERHAYS ESTATE - PERMISSIVE FOOTPATH, WEST PORTHOLLAND**

As Trustees of the Caerhays Maintenance Fund Trust (Owners of the freehold of the land in question (see plan attached) we confirm as follows:

There are no Public Rights of Way over the land other than those shown coloured red on the said plan which are indicated on the Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way for the area.

In particular we deny that the undermentioned path shown on the said map and coloured brown has been acknowledged/dedicated as a Public Right of Way.
