
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 31 (6)

I WENDY HIGLETT DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. The Woodland Trust, a company limited by guarantee and registered charity no. 294344, is and has been since 21<sup>st</sup> day of September 1981 the owner of the land known as Lavethan Wood, Blisland, Bodmin, more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 20<sup>th</sup> day of August 1991 my predecessor Linda Wilkinson deposited with Cornwall County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating our property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured purple on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths and no other ways had been dedicated as highways over our property.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 20<sup>th</sup> August 1991 referred to in 2 above and at the present time the Woodland Trust has no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over its property.



I SARAH PRIESTMAN DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:


1. The Woodland Trust, a company limited by guarantee and registered charity no. 294344, is and has been since 21 September 1981 the owner of the land known as Lavethan Wood, Bisland, near Bodmin, Cornwall more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 10 August 1991 the Woodland Trust deposited with Cornwall County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating our property by red edging which stated no ways had been dedicated as highways over our property.
3. On the 5 day of August 1997 my predecessor in title Laura Judson deposited with Cornwall County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statutory declaration dated 5 August 1997 stating that no additional ways had been dedicated since the deposit of the statement referred to in 2 above.
