

STATUTORY DECLARATION

1. The Woodland Trust, a company limited by guarantee and registered charity no. 294344, is and has been since 19th March 1986 the owner of the land known as Tregaynor Copse and Crannow Combe, Millook, Cornwall more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 5th day of May 1995 my predecessor Laura H Judson deposited with Cornwall Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating our property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured purple on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths no other ways had been dedicated as highways over our property.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 5th May 1995, referred to in 2 above and at the present time the Woodland Trust has no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over its property.
