

STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

We DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. We are the owners of the land known as the Pentillie Estate more particularly delineated on the map accompanying this Declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 6th day of December 1996 we deposited with Cornwall County Council, being the appropriate Council, a Statement accompanied by a map delineating my property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured green on the said map and on the map accompanying this Declaration had been dedicated as bridleways, the ways coloured purple on this said map and on the map accompanying this Declaration had been dedicated as footpaths. No other ways had been dedicated as highways over my property.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the map accompanying this Declaration since the Statement dated 6th December 1996 referred to in Clause 2 above and at the present time I have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over my property.

AND I MAKE this solemn Declaration on the 22nd day of April 2008 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
