NOTICE OF INTENTION NOT TO DEDICATE, OR IN ANY WAY

ALLOW A PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY TO OCCUR.

I understand that under current legislation, this is the formal process by which a landowner can register with you, a clear intention NOT to dedicate or in any way allow any Public Right of Way to occur.

I am the Freehold owner of land and buildings at Fisting Cove Gunwalloe near Helston, known as the Fisting Cellars. I notify you as follows:

1. At the time of purchase, approx. 10 years ago, searches with the County and District Authorities showed one public right of way crossing my land ~~to~~ N. to S. (North to South), being the Coastal Footpath.

2. Thus, there exists adequate facility for the Public to cross my land on foot. The Coastal Path is well defined both on the "Definitive Map" and on the ground.

3. During my Freehold ownership, I have not agreed in any way that any other Public Rights of Way exist.

4. In Addition, I have a personal 12 foot right of way with or without vehicles across a farmer's field. This is granted to me by deeds which I hold.

5. I formally notify you that I do not intend to allow or dedicate any Public Rights of Way across any of my land at Fisting Cove, except of course for the Coastal Footpath, strictly as shown on the Definitive Map.

Please find enclosed a copy of the O.S. Map for Fisting Cove, Gunwalloe, which shows the Coastal footpath and the extent of my property which is edged in Red.

I look forward to hearing from you and would appreciate confirmation that this application is technically correct. Yours faithfully
